Each year the Wisconsin Association of Housing Authorities which the Dodge County Housing Authority is a member of offers three scholarships to participants of housing programs throughout Wisconsin.

Wisconsin offering an associate or undergraduate degree or be a graduating High School Senior. A cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or higher is required.

One scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 for a full time student and two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each for a part-time student will be awarded this spring.

Homestead Tax/Rent Certificates

Several program participants have contacted us regarding Homestead Tax questions and Rent Certificates.

We cannot determine if you are eligible for a Homestead Tax refund. You can pick up a Homestead Tax form at several locations including your local library, post office, some banks or on-line at www.wisconsin.gov.

In order to file Homestead Tax you will need a rent certificate showing the amount of rent you paid. A blank rent certificate form is provided as part of the Homestead tax packet.

The rent certificate must be completed by your landlord. We cannot prepare a rent certificate for you or verify the amount of rent you paid to your landlord.

You should pay your rent by check or money order. If you pay in cash, you should get a receipt.

It is a good idea for you to keep your own record of the amount of rent you pay for the year in case there is a discrepancy with your landlord's records.

Resident Advisory Board

The Resident Advisory Board is comprised of HUD Housing Choice Voucher program participants and tenants of our senior apartment buildings.

This group meets on an as needed basis to review and discuss program changes.
