Make the decision based on the things that are important to you and things that are important to our society.


Do some research to find out information about the candidates position and his record. Don't rely on just commercials and media. Get the facts.

Volunteer Board Positions Available

The Housing Authority has 2 Volunteer Board Positions Available to program participants.

The **Resident Advisory Board** is comprised of HUD Housing Choice Voucher program participants and tenants of our senior apartment buildings. This group meets on an as needed basis (1 to 2 times per year) to review and discuss program changes in an advisory capacity.

The **Housing Authority Board** is comprised of 2 county supervisors and 3 members of the county including a HUD Housing Choice Voucher program participant. This group meets on the 4th Tuesday of each month in the morning.

Board members volunteer their time for the meetings but are reimbursed for mileage.

Voucher Program Update

Because of decreases in funding we have been reducing our program from 200+ households to 152. Due to the long wait time, the waiting list closed on July 31, 2003.

Though the waiting list remains closed, we have reduced to the point that we can start to add new households to replace those that go off the program.

We are now processing applications that were received on or before July 31, 2002.
