# TORNADO SAFETY INFORMATION



TORNADO AWARENESS WEEK IS APRIL 7TH – 11TH, 2003.

## EMERGENCY PLAN:

1. Have a N.O.A.A. Weather Alert Radio.
2. Create an emergency plan.
3. Know where your shelter area is.
4. Prepare a disaster supplies kit.
5. Practice your plan.

## TORNADO WATCH:

1. Sirens do not sound for a 'WATCH'.
2. A 'WATCH' means weather conditions are favorable for a tornado to form.
3. Listen to the radio, TV, or NOAA Weather Radio.
4. Cautiously observe the clouds and weather yourself.
5. Be prepared to go to your shelter area.
6. Check to make sure you have necessary supplies available.
7. Please don't call the police or fire department for information.

## TORNADO WARNING:

1. Sirens will sound for a 'WARNING'.
2. A "WARNING" means a tornado has been spotted in this area.
3. Listen to the radio, TV, or NOAA Weather Radio.
4. Have a battery-operated radio and a flashlight.
5. Stay inside. Know where your family members are.
6. Go to your safe shelter area you picked out beforehand.
7. There is NEVER a siren blown for an all clear signal.

## AFTER THE TORNADO PASSES:

1. Listen to the radio for information and instructions.
2. Inspect your home for damage.
3. Watch out for fallen power lines.
4. Stay out of the damaged areas.

A STATEWIDE TORNADO DRILL WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY, APRIL 10, 2003. THE DRILL WILL CONSIST OF A SIMULATED "WATCH" AT 1:15 P.M., FOLLOWED BY A SIMULATED TORNADO "WARNING" AT 1:45 P.M.

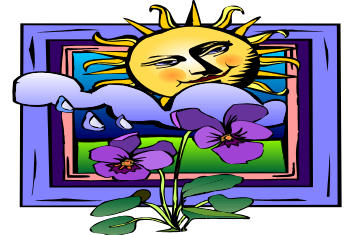

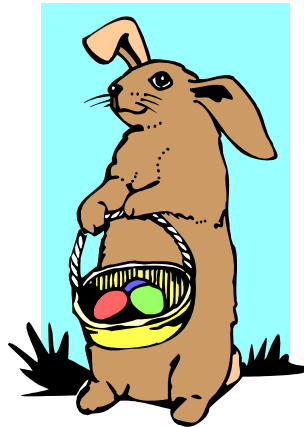
